

EHST PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

SWIM MEETS:

Our home swim meets are completely run by parents, so it is imperative that all parents participate. We need a member of each family to work at least three home meets. The following is a list of jobs needed to run a home swim meet. More than one parent can participate to meet the obligation.

Blanket judge	Work with a partner & list place that each lane finishes
Runner	Pick up slips from timers & take them to the scoring office
Clean up after meet	Assist w/general clean up including trash removal & hosing deck
Snack bar worker	Help set up/take down snack bar; assist customers; make change
Coaches' helper	Help line up 4 to 8-year-old swimmers and start races
Starter	Use timing system to announce and start races
Computer data entry	Enter race times into computer and print results
Stroke & turn judge	Judge legality of swimmers' strokes and turns (training provided)
Lane judge	6 people, 1 assigned to each lane to judge place swimmer finishes
Timer	3 timers per lane, use stop watches to get swimmers' times
Ribbons	Affix stickers to swimmers' ribbons
Announcer	Announce events, swimmer names & general info over PA system

DISCIPLINE:

You are responsible for disciplining your child during swim meets when the coaches are busy running the meet. If you are unaware of a problem with your child, a coach or board member may inform you. Please deal with the problem promptly so as to not delay the meet.
